The 2012 outdoor soccer season is rapidly approaching.

The Peterborough Youth Soccer Club invites you to register to participate in this year's activities. Eligible players are boys and girls born in years 1994 through 2007 and young men born since 1989.

The regular season will run from May 7th until the last week of August. There are no games on the Aug 6<sup>th</sup> Civic Holiday week. Regular season games are scheduled Monday through Thursday, beginning at 6:30 PM. Teams play one game per week, plus team practices. Regular attendance is expected to ensure a successful season.

A recreational club, PYSC's mandate is to create an enjoyable venue for exercise and learning the skills of the game.

The Ron Thompson All-Winners Tournament for all players will be held on Saturday, June 9th or Sunday 10th. Games will occur within a 4-hour period on Saturday for up to U10 players, or Sunday for older players.

There will be a playoff tournament for teams U11 and older held on a weekend in August or September (TBA).

In order to balance teams in the various divisions, the Club may transfer some players between teams.

We will endeavour to complete team balancing by the time of the All-Winners Tournament.

When attendance drops during the summer, younger registered players could be called up to play on older teams. Please note on the registration form your interest in being called up. Your name will be passed along to the higher division coaches.

The Peterborough City Soccer Association offers player training sessions, depending on interest.

Note your interest on the registration form and we will let you know about these sessions.

This year we might form an older, U22 division, or depending on numbers of players, organize team(s) in the KSSL.

The Club supplies a complete uniform, which is to be worn by the player. Players must wear shin guards completely covered by the soccer socks. Soccer jerseys should be tucked into shorts during play. Jewellery (watches, rings, piercings, etc) **CANNOT** be worn during games because of potential injury.

**Coaches:** We will need Coaches for the new season. To coach, you need to provide a few hours each week for games and practices. We will be having coaching training. There is Head Coach assistance and resource material available; see our website. Volunteer Screening applies for coaches and assistants. **WE NEED YOU!** Submit a coach's registration form, call 705 743 0482.

**Referees:** If you want to become a referee you need to be 14 or older by March 31 of this year (OSA rules).
